




Age







Amber and Jack spent almost 2 months in the pediatric hospital after their daughter, Charlotte, was born. Charlotte required around-the-clock care, so Amber and Jack needed to stay near the hospital. Due to their circumstances, Amber and Jack found themselves trying to relocate their other three children from the Florida Panhandle during this time. To stay close to Charlotte, both Amber and Jack accepted jobs at the hospital and took turns taking care of their beautiful baby girl. As the family was nearing discharge, they needed to remain near the hospital for Charlotte's ongoing medical treatment. Only one problem, they still had nowhere permanent to stay locally. Amber and Jack's case manager at the hospital reached out to St. Francis House, and one of our staff was able to meet with the family at the hospital. With the help of St. Francis House, Amber, Jack, and their kids now have a reliable place to call home!

Nicole and her young son, Liam, had found themselves living in and out of hotels for over a year after heartbreaking personal setbacks. Before that time, the family had a beautiful and quiet place to call home. An unexpected tragedy occurred and changed the entire family's lives overnight. Sadly, one of Nicole's children passed away and Liam lost his older brother. Unfortunately, combined grief and trauma caused this family to experience homelessness after such a tragic situation. With nowhere else to turn, Nicole reached out to St. Francis House for assistance and support. Nicole works multiple jobs, and through her perseverance and the encouragement of her case manager at St. Francis House, Nicole and Liam have a safe and affordable place where they can begin to heal together and create their new home.
